# Steps to access the test out option for courses

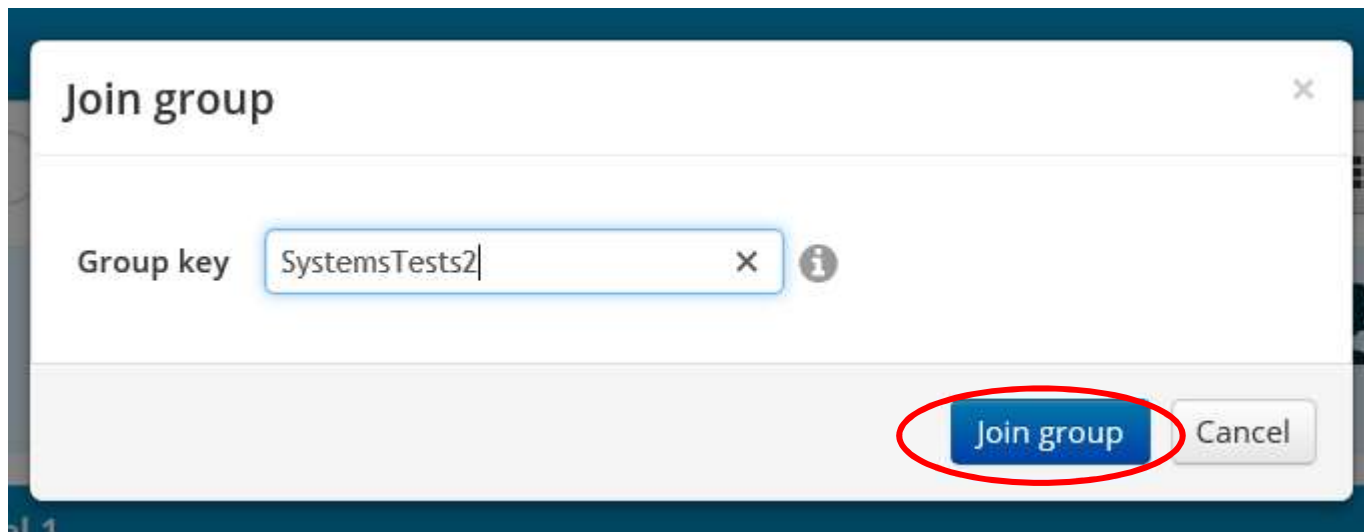
On your home page you will need to click on Join group on right side of page to get access to the test out option

To begin click on Level 2 Standalone Tests



## Steps to access the test out option for courses

---

You then can click the start course (blue button) and begin – you will be able to test out of the courses you desire to gain credit - If you fail the test you will have to complete the course prior to taking test again

- All tests out are one try tests
- The test out process is not an automatic process within the SAI LMS
  - If you pass the test you will need to contact your SAI Rep to gain credit for course
  - If you fail a test – you will need to join the Level 1 course group to take that course
- If you have any questions on the test out process – please contact you SAI Regional Rep to get answers

## Steps to access the test out option for courses



- Once they have been contacted they will work with you and answer any questions you may have
- Remember, you only get one try for all test out exams – no exceptions.



# Steps to access the test out option for courses

- When logging back into the LMS you will always be taken back to your home page – you can just click on the course you are working on and it will take you to that course.
- Remember, courses have to be taken in the order they are listed.
